### Key Ideas and Details

- Who, what, where, when, why, and how
- Recount stories (fables, folktales, etc.) & determine central message, lesson, moral
- Describe how characters respond to major events & challenges

#### Craft and Structure

- Describe how rhythm supplies meaning in stories and songs
- Story structure—beginning, middle, end
- Acknowledge differences in points of view of character

### Integration of Knowledge and Ideas

- Use information from illustrations and words to demonstrate understanding of characters, setting, plot
- Compare and contrast two or more versions of the same story

## The Informational Text Grade Includes the Following:

#### Key Ideas and Details

- Who, what, where, why, when, and how
- Identify main topic of a multiparagraph text
- Describe connection between historical events, scientific ideas, and technical procedures

### Craft and Structure

- Determine the meaning of words and phrases
- Know and use text features (captions, bold, subheadings, glossaries, indexes, electronic menus, icons, etc.)
- Identify the main purpose of a text (what does the author want to answer, explain, describe)

## Integration of Knowledge and Ideas

- Explain how images contribute to text for clarification
- Describe how reasons support points the author makes about the text
- Compare and contrast the most important points presented by two texts on the same topic
